2020\_21 Harry E. Taylor Canadian Indigenous Graduate Prize in Education (#1996)

**AWARD CRITERIA:**

Two prizes of \$550 have been endowed through a bequest from Stanley Taylor to honour his father, Harry E. Taylor, for Canadian Indigenous students in a Faculty of Education graduate program who are specializing in research that will have a positive impact on improving Canadian Indigenous education. The award is made on the recommendation of the Faculty of Education, in consultation with the Associate Dean for Indigenous Education and the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

The award will be given in recognition of a graduate student based on: (1) the quality of his or her academic achievement and scholarship in the field of Indigenous education; and (2) the degree to which that scholarly work has informed or has the potential to have a positive impact on improving Canadian Indigenous education.

**ELIGIBILITY**

- To be eligible for the Harry E. Taylor award, applicants must be Canadian Indigenous graduate students enrolled in the Faculty of Education at UBCV.
- To be eligible for any UBC-administered awards (scholarships and prizes), applicants must be full-time graduate students. Magistral students on the part-time fee payment schedule (Schedule B) are not eligible to apply. To be eligible, Magistral students must be on the full-time fee payment schedule (Schedule A). All Doctoral students are on a full-time fee payment schedule. Students on Leave are not eligible to apply.
- To be eligible for this UBC-administered prize, students must have been officially registered in the 2020 Winter Term in the Faculty of Education (FoE) at UBCV.
